Steps to Apply

STEP 1. (Feb.)	Apply to Scholarship program with home university's nomination https://www.cmkfoundation-globalscholarship.org/
STEP 2.	Interview with CMK Foundation
STEP 3.	Announcement of interview results with applicant's expected Korean University
STEP 4.	Apply to the Korean university
STEP 5.	Screening process of the Korean University
STEP 6. (May)	Final announcement

※ All scholarship funds are paid to Korean university, and then distributed to each student by the university after their Korean bank account is created. It takes about two months to open an account in Korea, so it is highly recommended to prepare individual funds in advance.

3. Qualifications (at the time of application)

※ This is minimum qualification to apply for scholarship program. Applicants have to check each Korean university's qualification which they want to apply. Some of them require higher standard than below.

a.	The applicant's home university must have a partnership with CMK Foundation.				
	*Partnership universities with CMK Foundation - Indonesia: University of Indonesia, Bandung Institute of Technology, Gadjah Mada University, and President University - Vietnam: Vietnam National University, Hanoi, Vietnam National University Ho Chi Minh City, Duytan University				
b.	The applicant must be currently enrolled as a full-time student for a bachelor's degree at their home university.				
c.	The applicant should be nominated by their home university.				
	* Please check with the applicant's home university scholarship officer.				
d.	The applicant must hold citizenship in their home university's country.				
e.	Completion of at least the second semester of the home university before the application period is required.				
f.	The applicant should major in one of the four fields				
	① Business & Economics ② Future Industry (Climate technology, new energy industry, intelligence information technology, bio-health etc.) ③ Korean & Korean studies ④ Politics & Public development (International relations, development etc.)				
g.	A minimum GPA of 2.5/4.0 is required for Indonesian University. (According to agreement)				
	A minimum GPA of 3.0/4.0 is required for Vietnamese University. (According to MoU)				
h.	The applicant must be fluent in either Korean or English and must have a below language score certificate in either Korean or English.

4. Required Documents

※ The following documents are required specifically for the scholarship program. Applicants must check the specific required documents for each Korean university to which they intend to apply.

a.	Copy of passport
b.	Official academic transcripts
	* Must be written in English, cover at least two full semesters, and use a grade 4.0 scale.
c.	Recommendation from home university
	*It will be sent directly to CMK Foundation from the home university.
d.	Others: Any official documents to prove the capacity of applicants. (e.g., language score documents, prizes, working experience, etc.).
	*All official documents must include the date, host institution, and stamp (or signature).
